
Bar Charts S1-S3, National 4

Eco:86 votesHealth:24 votesFairtrade:52 votesCommunity:18 votes


Using a suitable scale, draw a bar chart to show this information.

2. A school conducted a survey to establish the number of its students who worked. The compound bar chart below gives the results of the data collected.




Students Who Worked Ages 14-18
