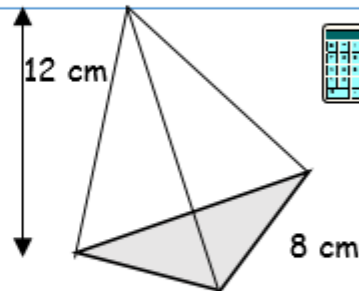
1. Multiply out and simplify when necessary.

g) $(4p - 9)^2$ h) $(8h - 7)^2 + (2 - 5h)^2$
i) $(x + 5)(x^2 - 4x + 3)$
