Which size of bottle offers better value for money?
5. Sugar can be bought in 1 kilogram costing 86 pence or 2 kilogram bags costing $£ 1.55$.

13. Brian is a student and goes to the cinema regularly. It costs him $£ 4.50$ to get into the cinema but he can buy an unlimited monthly pass for £14.
(a) How many visits to the cinema in one month must Brian make for a monthly pass to be better value?

(b) Brian buys a monthly pass and goes to the cinema 8 times in the month. How much money does he save?
14. Michael is a season ticket holder at Dundee United football club. His season ticket costs him $£ 280$ and guarantees him entry to 20 home games. Without a season ticket, entry to each game costs $£ 18.50$.

If Michael attends all 20 home games, how much does he save by having a season ticket?

15. Samia wants to improve her fitness levels and is going to go to a gym. She can pay $£ 5.20$ for each session in the gym or buy a monthly pass costing $£ 55$ which means she can use the gym as often as she wants.
(a) If she buys a monthly pass, how often must she use the gym in a month to make the monthly pass worthwhile?
(b) During the first month she has a pass she uses the gym 15 times.
 How much money does she save by buying the pass?
